

Bowlers Association of Sun City West (BASCW) Policy Changes for 2021 No Tap Season

1. The Start Date is **Saturday October 10**. We will bowl every other Saturday night, except for Holidays (see 2021 Season Calendar).
2. You **MUST** sign up in the book at the bowling center or by emailing Helen Bootman at halfaboot@msn.com. The deadline to sign up is Friday October 2. If you paid when you signed up in March, then you owe no money. If you did **NOT** pay in March, then you should pay your \$10 to bowl. There will be a list of those who prepaid in March so you can refer to that list to check if you need to pay.
3. Only 2 (two) bowlers per lane are allowed. 4 (four) bowlers per pair of lanes. We know this may create a challenge to bowl with your friends but do your best to sign up next to each other. We are limited to 60 people for a bowling session.
4. **NOTE TIME START CHANGE:** Bowling start time will be 4:00 pm. It is possible if we exceed the limit of 60 bowlers, we would have to have a second session starting at 6:30 pm. This will **ONLY** occur if we have more than 60 bowlers sign up.
5. The 3-6-9, 300 pots, and 50/50 drawing will be maintained. We want to minimize the handling of cash so we would appreciate EXACT change for whatever you are participating in. **NO CHANGE WILL BE GIVEN IF YOU ARE PARTICIPATING IN THESE EVENTS!**
6. Bowling membership dues - Due to the Pandemic of this year, we will NOT be charging any member who paid in 2020 and wishes to renew their membership for 2021. Brand new members or previous members who did not participate in 2020 will still pay the \$10 annual membership fee for 2021. The membership year goes from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021.
7. Bowling center rules for safe bowling include the wearing of masks while in the bowling center and while bowling. You can lower the mask below your nose or chin while you are on the approach and bowling. Your mouth and nose must be covered when you in the settee area. Please try to maintain social distancing when you are not bowling. If these rules are not adhered to, our club privileges could be taken away. If you can't abide by these simple rules, then you may need to sit out for a year until we return to normal.
8. No food is allowed at our meetings, but we do need to elect 3 new board members for 2021. Please consider volunteering for one of these positions so our club can continue.
9. For those of you who choose not to bowl this year, please contact Helen Bootman at halfaboot@msn.com. You may collect your rollover back payment, No-Tap and/or 3-6-9 prize money on any Saturday night that we bowl. If you choose not to enter the bowling alley, you can make arrangements to collect your money by contacting Bob Engen (BASCW treasurer) at engenbob@gmail.com. Please note, any rollover or prize fund money not collected by December 31, 2020 will be donated back to the BASCW club. The club's website is bascw.net.
